- Maintaining records of student attendance, participation, and performance.
- Ensuring student compliance with all classroom/camp policies and procedures and managing disciplinary issues and conflicts that may arise.
- Working in various sectors of the company! Majority of the time will be spent
 on community development project but candidates are expected to take on
 tasks related to other fields (such as marketing) to gain a variety of
 experiences.
