- Creating promotional materials such as newsletters and flyers to share volunteering opportunities with schools and volunteer networks and on Eventbrite.
- Developing, scheduling, and leading event-specific training for volunteers.
- Working in various sectors of the company! Majority of the time will be spent
 on community development projects but candidates are expected to take
 on tasks related to other fields (such as marketing and curriculum planning)
 to gain a variety of experiences.
